At Oakwell Hall, Final Details

Regional Event 21st December 2025

Terrain: This is a small and not very technical area and unfortunately we are unable to use the fields and barn area near the upper car park due to a SEND event taking place. This has all been marked as out of bounds on the map. Consequently blue and green courses will visit some of the same controls more than once. The blue and green courses both have double sided maps. It can be very wet and muddy so shoes with a good grip are highly recommended. Apologies for those doing both the night and day event as you may encounter some similar leg combinations. White and Yellow courses have some smiley faces to keep them on the correct path. Check that you follow the correct smiley which are labelled 'WHITE', 'YELLOW' or 'WHITE AND YELLOW' (where both courses go the same way).

The white course visits control 90 near the end and other courses are likely to pass nearby. Please note that there is a small bit of path mapped nearby which doesn't exist but the control is in the correct place. A map with a correction will be displayed near assembly and at the start. Also a smiley face is in place to help the white and yellow course.

Map: 1:4000 on A4

Car Parking: This will be at the country park end Nutter Lane car park, adjacent to Miss Molly Moo's Ice Cream Shop, signed Country Centre and Play area. **Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES should you use the Hall car park. This area is out of bounds to Orienteers as there is a special event for SEND children on at the Hall.**

Parking will be tight, camper vans cannot be accommodated as there is a height barrier.

Public transport: the 283 Bradford—Dewsbury bus stops at the end of Nutter Lane, a 5 minute walk.

Nearest postcode: WF17 9LF

What 3 words: belts. abode.sugars

Enquiries and download: in the café. This is very small so I am afraid there is no room for leaving belongings other than car keys. The café is adjacent to the car park and is less than 100m to start and finish.

Facilities: Café, limited toilets, play park. Please **DO** buy drinks etc from the café as they have been very generous in putting us up for both the night and day event.

Entries: . **Entries are closed as we have reached the limit.**

Courtesy: This area is very popular with the general public, particularly dog walkers, please show courtesy when moving through the area, and caution around horses and dogs.
